SUBJECT: Policy Letter 7-3, Restrictions on the Use of Youth Sports & Fitness Fields for Military Training

1. Reference. Order of Garrison Commander.
2. Purpose. To establish the Garrison policy for use of Youth Sports & Fitness Fields for Military Training.
3. Applicability. All Soldiers, their Family Members, Retirees, DoD Civilians, Local National employees, NATO unit Soldiers, and authorized guests.
4. Policy. Child, Youth School Services (CYSS) fields are to be used solely for sports activities and are off-limits to military units for training purposes. Vehicles, heavy equipment, firearms, alcohol and tobacco are off limits on all Youth Sports & Fitness fields. The MP Field may be reserved for Unit Physical Training (PT) by contacting the CYSS Youth Sports & Fitness Office at DSN 485-7210. Units using MP Field for PT are responsible for clean-up following use.
5. All CYSS fields are clearly designated with signs at each of the five locations:
 - a. Village Garrett Field, located off Bradley Boulevard, on Ordinance Road behind Building 8229
 - b. Castle Field, located behind the Shoppette
 - c. Aulenbach Field, located just outside Chicago Gate on Abrams Avenue
 - d. Commissary Field, located at the end of Commissary Road, past the Recycling Center
 - e. MP Field, located off Fruit Street and Old Ironsides Avenue below Building 8350
