




# Hazardous Waste Fact Sheet USAG Baumholder



## Common types of Hazardous Waste (HW) generated in the Garrison:

- Batteries
- Solvents
- Paint
- Asbestos brake shoes
- Antifreeze
- Acids and bases
- Adhesives, glue
- Automotive grease
- EasyDecon, DS2, STB
- Brake fluid
- Hydraulic fluid
- NBC filters
- Oily rags and used absorbent material
- Used oil filters
- Lab packs, CDE kits
- Cleaners/degreasers/detergents/soap
- Spray cans
- Waste oil, POL
- Empty containers previously containing hazardous material (metal drums, plastic)
- Waxes and polishes (car, floor, metal, wood, etc)



## Storage and accumulation

### Containers

- Keep containers closed
- Prevent leaks
- Segregate incompatible wastes
- Clearly mark HW storage containers which waste is collected there

### Labels

- For labeling requirements contact the Environmental Division (DSN: 485-6621)

### Tanks

- Do not flush dry sweep and other materials down the sink
- Do not mix different waste streams

### Inspections

- Inspect tanks / monitoring systems daily
- Inspect the HW accumulation points weekly
- Document the inspections and keep it on file

### Batteries

- Store batteries in a dry place (especially lithium batteries)

### Compressed gas cylinders (CGCs)

- Segregate flammable and oxidizing gases
- Store CGCs in a upright position with safety cap and secured from toppling

## General information

- For Hazardous Waste disposal read the flyer “How to get rid of your Hazardous Waste”
- Order a pick up when a container is 3/4 full
- The Hazardous Waste Storage Facility is located at Bldg. #8468
- Every Hazardous Waste Accumulation Point must be labeled with hazard signs according to the different Hazard Characteristic Codes (HCC) stored
